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ORDER:

The Ministry of Rural Development implements a number of programmes through the State Government for poverty alleviation, employment generation, development of infrastructure and area development in the rural areas. For improving the delivery system in terms of both effectiveness and efficiency there is an immediate need to ensure that the programmes are executed as per Guidelines, so that the benefits reach the rural poor and under developed areas in full measure. To achieve this objective, the Government of India have suggested constitution of Vigilance and Monitoring Committee at State Level and District Levels and they have formulated a set of guidelines in this regard. The Guidelines provide for composition and Terms of reference for Sate Level Vigilance and Monitoring Committee.

2. In the Government Orders 1st and 2nd read above, consequent upon the formation of the 14th Lok Sabha, the State Level Vigilance and Monitoring Committee has been constituted. In the letter 3rd read above, the Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India has informed that with the coming into being of the 15th Lok Sabha, the State and District Vigilance and Monitoring Committees constituted earlier to monitor the implementation of Rural Development Programmes stand dissolved with immediate effect.

3. In the letter 4th read above, the Government of India have nominated the following Members of Parliament and Non Officials and Non Government Organisation representative for the State Level Vigilance and Monitoring Committee.

- 4. The terms of reference of the above committee is as follows:
- (i) The Vigilance & Monitoring Committee at State Level would supervise, exercise vigilance and monitor the implementation of Programmes of the Ministry of Rural Development.
- (ii) The Committee would monitor the flow of funds through various channels, including allocations, releases, utilization and unspent balances.
- (iii) The Committee should ensure that the schemes are implemented as per the Guidelines.

- (iv) The Committee would look into complaints received in respect of the implementation of the Programmes, including complaints of mis-appropriation / diversion of funds and recommend follow-up actions.
- (v) The Committee would take all necessary measures to ensure that programme benefits flow to the rural poor in full measure.
- (vi) The Committee would consider Evaluation Reports, Area Officers' Reports and other such Reports sent and would cause to take necessary follow up action and corrective measures wherever required.
