Instances have come to the notice of this Ministry that the provisions of para 3.22 of MPLADS Guidelines are not being adhered to by many District Authorities. It is reiterated that the following provisions of para 3.22 should be strictly followed by all the District Authorities.

"As soon as a work under the scheme is completed, it should be put to public use. For greater public awareness, for all works executed under MPLADS, a plague (stone / metal) carrying the inscription 'Member of Parliament Local Area Development Scheme Work' indicating the cost involved, the commencement, completion and inauguration date and the name of the MP sponsoring the project should be permanently erected".
