## ORDER:

The Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj, in the letter first read above, has stated that Dr.S. Vasudevan, Principal Investigator, Coordinator/Associate Professor, Centre for Geographic Information Technologies, School of Geosciences, Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirappalli has submitted the Project proposal of "NREGAGIT" (NREGA Implementation through Geographic Information Technologies for Tamil Nadu State) along with a copy of the letter from Registrar, Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirappalli.

2. The Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has also stated that the main objective of the proposal is to prepare a strategy for nationwide rollout and evolve parameters for standardization with an objective to link Geographic Information System with grass root level participatory planning, asset management and monitoring, which will enable access to real time data and help in ensuring greater transparency

and accountability in the implementation of the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme. This project proposal also envisages preparation of road Network map/segment, formatting of the existing water body layer, flood protection site, etc. through Geographic Information Technology which will provide the exact picture of the work status like when was the work started, how many persons involved, total number of man days involved in a particular work place etc.

3. The Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has further stated that it is proposed in the project proposal "NREGAGIT" to constitute a Project Review and Steering Group (PRSG) with the Principal Secretary of Department of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj as Chairperson to periodically evaluate the progress to ensure successful completion and timely delivery of project outputs. Project Review and Steering Group will be empowered to discuss/resolve matters related to both technical and financial aspects. Policies taken in the Project Review and Steering Group will be final and project will be evaluated based on the decisions taken by the Project Review and Steering Group. Project Review and Steering Group will meet at least once in every four months preferably at Chennai. The tentative composition of the Project Review and Steering Group (PRSG) shall be as detailed below:

The Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has also stated that since application of Geographic Information Technologies, such as, Remote Sensing, Global Positioning System (GPS) and Geographic Information System (GIS) will enable to implement Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme in a better way, the proposal may be forwarded to Government of India, Ministry of Rural Development for taking further action. The total cost of the Project proposal viz., NREGAGIT is Rs.2916.87 lakhs.
- 5. With reference to the Project proposal viz., NREGAGIT, in the letter second read above, the Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India has suggested, among others, that the project needs to be implemented on pilot basis in a district so that its utility and efficacy can be tested. As the University has the data for Pudukottai District, it may be tried out on a pilot basis in that district, if the State Government so desires.
- 6. The Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj, in the letter third read above, has stated that the Principal Investigator, GIS, Tiruchirappali, has sent the PILOT project proposal for implementation in 4 Districts namely Pudukkottai (497 Village Panchayats), Thanjavur (589 Village Panchayats), Krishnagiri (333 Village Panchayats) and Ramanathapuram (429 Village Panchayats) at an estimated cost of Rs.142.60 lakhs covering 1848 village panchayats in order to assess the different kind of field realities and requested to approve and review pilot Project proposal of NREGAGIT in 4 Districts comprising of 1,848 Village Panchayats.
- 7. In the State Level Co-ordination Committee on GIS / RS meeting held on 23.07.2012, it has been decided that the proposed pilot study may be taken up, and the outcome, benefits and administrative issues could be carefully studied to decide on the utility of the method for better monitoring of the NREGA programme.
- 8. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj and decision taken in the State Level Co-ordination Committee on GIS / RS meeting held on 23.7.2012, approve the pilot project proposal NREGA implementation through Geographic Information Technologies (NREGAGIT) for Tamil Nadu State at a cost of Rs.142.60 lakhs for implementation in four districts namely Pudukottai, Thanjavur, Krishnagiri and Ramanathapuram subject to the condition that the expenditure involved in the proposal should be met out from the 6% administrative cost of MGNREGA and direct that the Project Review and Steering Group (PRSG) be constituted as mentioned below:
