ORDER

In the Government Order first read above, Government have issued special rules for the Tamil Nadu Panchayat Development Service. Among others, the Rules for the post of Divisional Development Officer were issued in this Government Order. In the Government Order Second read above, the post of Divisional Development Officer was redesignated as Development Officer (Panchayats) and Development Officer (Audit).

2. The following Notification will be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Panchayat Development Service (Section 39 in Volume II of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual 1969)

2. The amendments hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st August 1997.

AMENDMENTS

In the said Rules,

- (1) for the expression "Divisional Development Officer" wherever occurs except in Explanation 2 to rule 1, the expression Development Officer (Panchayats) / Development Officer (Audit)Personal Assistant (Panchayat Development) to Collector" shall be substituted.
 - (2) In rule 1, for the Explanation 2, the following Explanation shall be substituted namely: -

Explanation 2: Development Officer (Panchayats) / Development Officer (Audit), Personal Assistant (Panchayat Development) to Collector" shall mean Personal Assistant and Additional Personal Assistant to the Director of Rural Development, Vice Principals in Rural Extension Training Centre and State Institute of Rural Development and Lecturers in State Institute of Rural Development.
